

July 2019 Update

Welcome to the latest edition of our First Class Funds list.

Thank you for your feedback on the list. We are always keen to know what you think about it and the ways in which you think it can be improved.

The output of financial news services has been dominated by the suspension of the LF Woodford Equity Income fund in recent weeks. Whilst this is, clearly, a major news issue, it is interesting to reflect that the fund came off our list 12 months ago after a sustained period of underperformance.

It is perhaps worth re-stating how our list is put together. We use the opinions of specialist rating agencies, whose job it is to dig deeper into a fund's structure and processes, to try to identify areas of strength or weakness. We combine this with statistical data of the funds recent performance. We acknowledge that we do not have the knowledge or resources to look into the thousands of funds available to clients to perform this level of analysis and so, our opinion does not form part of the First Class Funds' process.

In other fund news the Jupiter European fund has been removed from the list following the news that star fund manager, Alex Darwall, is leaving Jupiter.

We hope that the new list and the latest Fundwatch magazine give you some food for thought. Our website has much more information for you, should you wish to do a little more research.

Why we provide a Fund List

There are many things to consider when investing but perhaps the most important, is which fund or funds you choose.

There are over 2,500 funds in the UK. Whilst there is plenty of information available to the investor – fund facts, manager interviews, performance information, fund analysis and comment – sorting the wheat from the chaff and finding the best funds can be time-consuming and challenging.

The First Class Funds list is designed to help you find well managed, proven funds that may satisfy the investment objectives you have set yourself.

We have gone through the process of collating research and information that is available, some of it readily accessible, some of it less so, and refining it in to a streamlined list of funds across a variety of sectors.

The list isn't definitive, but it is independent. The strict criteria that we have developed are adhered to – if the fund does not meet those criteria then it doesn't make the cut. Fund groups cannot pay to have their funds included. We are only interested in funds that make it on merit.

Think of the list as a starting point for identifying the funds that are right for your own circumstances.

We update the list half-yearly. Updates are available on request by post or email and for download from our website.

How we choose The Funds

Our First Class Funds list has been built and is maintained based on a strict process for evaluation of a fund.

The aim of our process is to be objective in the criteria that are used to filter funds down to the final list. We have, however, had to make some subjective decisions along the way.

From the initial universe of around 2,500 UK retail funds we have filtered out those which are less than three years old and/or smaller than £50million.

Once the initial filtering is complete we look at the opinions of major fund rating agencies. Their analysts assess funds on both a qualitative and quantitative basis and only a minority of funds even qualify for a rating.

At this stage the funds are organised into sectors before we apply the performance ratings.

The FE crown fund ratings are applied to equity funds. For bond funds, we overlay Lipper Leader ratings. Only funds scoring highly enough will qualify for our First Class Funds list.

The list is updated on a half-yearly basis over the calendar year. Changes are highlighted and an updated list published shortly after the end of each period.
